What Can We TeleHELP You With?

• Clinical work up of HIV, hepatitis C, and substance use disorders of your patients.

How Does TeleHELP Work?

- Your patient will have an account generated in the UCHealth electronic medical record and will be scheduled for a telehealth visit in one of 2 ways:
 - » Patients can see us privately, at their convenience, on their own electronic device.
 - » Patients can see us while in the local health provider office in order to better coordinate care; the local provider can (but does not have to) remain the main healthcare provider for the follow up, with or without additional TeleHELP visits as appropriate.

Which Patients Are Eligible?

- Anyone 18 years of age or older, with access to email.
- Patients must have access to an internet enabled smartphone, tablet or a computer to allow for audio and video transmission of the telehealth visit.

What Are The Benefits?

- No need for patients to travel in order to see a specialist.
- No need for the primary provider to wait for a delayed specialty consultation.
- When telehealth visits are conducted in conjunction with the primary provider, no need to wait for delayed delivery of reports.
